

To avoid a Surcharge:

- The minimum size must be $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$
- The maximum size must be $6.125^{\prime \prime} \times 11.5^{\prime \prime}$
- The maximum thickness is $0.25^{\prime \prime}$

This template shows the minimum size mailing piece which will be accepted and the dimensions which are subject to surcharge for first- and thir-class pieces weighing up to one ounce.
The aspect ratio of a mailing piece (length divided by height) should fall between 1.3 to 1 and 2.5 to 1 . Example: \#10 env is $4.125^{\prime \prime} \times 9.5^{\prime \prime}$ - the aspect ratio is 2.3 so the envelope is mailabile.
